I am thrilled to share the news that we will begin classes on **Tuesday, September 8th with face to face instruction**. Students who opted for distance (virtual) learning will also begin on that date. Please review the following reminders:

- ALL students will receive free breakfast and lunch for the 2020-2021 school year.
- No visitors are allowed in buildings without an appointment. This policy will be reviewed at the end of first quarter (October 28, 2020). Each campus has a drop box for items. If you need to pick up your child for an appointment or illness, please call prior to arriving.
- Bus routes have changed. If you need information on transportation, call Mr. Byassee, assistant superintendent.
- Screen your child each morning prior to arrival. If he/she exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19, please keep them at home.
- Any changes in the school schedule (dismissal, classroom or building closure, etc.) will be announced on the district website, social media and through School Messenger.
- Staff and students will be required to wear face coverings throughout the school day. This is a change from the information provided in the re-entry plan and is due to the increased risk in our community at this time.
