## **EP R-II SRCSP PLAN**

The objective of this plan is to provide a positive educational experience for all students in the EP R-II School District in a safe, secure, stable, and healthy learning environment.

East Prairie R-II School District will begin the 2021-22 school year in Phase One with a traditional school schedule. This means that all students attend in-person each day of the 2021-22 school year.

### **Phase One consists of regular school days with basic preventative measures**

Key points for the safe start of 2021-22 school year:

- Good handwashing hygiene is expected
- Masks may be worn voluntarily
- Bus transportation will include sanitation after each route
- Restroom breaks may be staggered for spacing
- Parents, students, and employees will be trained and reminded regularly of the symptoms and county-wide status of COVID-19
- Students and employees are encouraged to stay home if they are experiencing symptoms
- A strict cleaning regimen is in place
- We will closely monitor the presence of visitors to our campuses, especially where they could contact children or employees.
- Although we do NOT anticipate any closures, we are aware that there is still the possibility of short-term and/or long-term dismissal of individual classes, schools, or the entire district under the direction of the Mississippi County Health Department
- We will continue to rely upon the Mississippi County Health Department for guidance on COVID-19
- We will seek input as we monitor and adjust our strategies to provide a safe, secure, healthy, and stable learning environment

### **Phases of Operation:**

If pandemic conditions return, our 2020-21 Re-Entry plan includes Phases 2-5 that **may** be instituted.
